Dr Sihoe received his medical training at the University of Cambridge, where he was awarded multiple prizes and received an Honours degree and a Masters degree for research in Pathology. After practicing in Scotland and England, he relocated to China and now practices as a Specialist in Thoracic Surgery in three major cities: Hong Kong, Shenzhen and Shanghai.

Dr Sihoe is an internationally recognized expert and advocate of ‘next generation’ minimally invasive thoracic surgery techniques – especially Uniportal and Needlescopic surgery of the chest. He has authored or co-authored over 150 book chapters, journal articles, and conference abstracts. His work has won or been short-listed for multiple awards in thoracic surgery,

including from the European Society of Thoracic Surgeons and the International Society for Minimally Invasive Cardiothoracic Surgery. Today, he is one of the most frequently invited teachers in thoracic surgery in the world, and has extensively delivered hundreds of lectures, performed live surgery, and taught in thoracic surgery skills workshops on every continent on earth.
