I am currently a member of the editorial boards for Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology, Journal de Radiologie. I've reviewed for several national and international scientific journals on medical imaging and respiratory diseases, such as Journal de Radiologie, Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology, European Radiology, Insight into Imaging, Respiration, European Journal of Radiology, Intensive Care Medicine. At the present time, I'm conducting research on ultra-low dose CT for detection and characterization of lung nodules and I expect to start soon a program of MR of lung parenchyma in patients with cystic fibrosis.
