This encompasses approximately 45 senior medical staff, large ambulatory clinical areas at both hospitals, day therapy areas at each of the hospitals and a radiation oncology department at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, including five linear accelerators. Several surgical services, such as breast surgery, head and neck surgery, urology, melanoma, and gynaecologic oncology were also part of the Centre.

Area Director of Cancer Services, Sydney South West Area Health Service, 2006 - 2009. The Sydney South West Area Health Service spanned from the centre of Sydney to Bowral. Significant cancer activities occurred at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, Concord Hospital, Bankstown Hospital, Liverpool Hospital and Campbelltown Hospital. This role provided overall clinical governance leadership across these sites and was responsible for overseeing these services and troubleshooting problems.

Head, Department of Medical Oncology, Sydney Cancer Centre 1995 – 2006. Leadership of a department of 10 senior medical staff across two hospitals. Initiated and oversaw projects included the development of standardised chemotherapy report forms, and development of electronic record keeping within Cerner Powerchart.
